You Control PrEP

PrEP is a medication taken daily by HIV-negative people that lowers their chances of getting infected. This is especially important during pregnancy and breastfeeding, when studies have proven your chances of catching HIV are much higher!

PrEP Works!

When PrEP is taken daily during and after pregnancy it can lower your chances of catching HIV, and infecting your baby with HIV.

When you are safe, you both are safe!

If babies catch HIV while in the womb, it can be serious. If you live in a place where HIV is common, it makes sense to use PrEP!

PrEP can be a safe choice during pregnancy & breastfeeding.

We offer PrEP to pregnant & breastfeeding women here.
